2. The selected candidate will be appointed on deputation basis initially for a period of three years which may be extended from time to time by the competent authority as per rules. The applicant should have a minimum of four years service left as on the last date of receipt of applications.

3. Only such recommendations, as are accompanied by the requisite personal data in Annexure-II will be considered. Officers, who once volunteer for the post(s), will not be permitted to withdraw their names later.

4. Willing candidates may send their applications through proper channel in the prescribed Performa (Annexure II) along with attested copies of CRs for the last five years, within 45 days from the date of publication of the vacancy circular in the Employment News. Application received after the last date or without the CR dossiers or otherwise found incomplete will not be considered. While forwarding the applications, it may also be verified and certified that the particulars furnished by the officers are correct and no disciplinary proceedings are either pending or contemplated against him/her.
